

## New Baden Park Board Meeting - May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012

The meeting of the Park Board of the Village of New Baden was called to order at 7:04 p.m. at the Village Hall by President, Bob Nielsen.

Members present were: Bob Nielsen, Tim Hintz, Calvin Beckmann, Nicole Jasper and Jordan Pettibone. Also present were Dave Brandmeyer (Mayor) Jimmy Morani (Village Administrator) and Rene Meinhardt (Parks and Recreation Manager). Bonnie Zurliene was not present and has resigned as a park board member.

The March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012 minutes were read and approved.

### Master Plan

The date of May 8<sup>th</sup> from 5-7 was set for the Public Master Plan Meeting. There will be an aerial view of the park and a blow-up photo of the civic center.

Jordan Pettibone presented the proposed mailer. Also, he needs to set up a survey to be filled out the evening of May 8<sup>th</sup>.

We will advertise the meeting on the firehouse sign and ask the local churches to advertise in their bulletins. It will also be advertised in the May 2<sup>nd</sup> Trenton Sun.

Jimmy will create a sign-up sheet and have 4 dozen cookies from Berkemann's plus bottled water.

### Pool

The Mayor proposed that we change the opening date of the pool to May 23<sup>rd</sup>; a motion was made by Calvin Beckmann and seconded by Tim Hintz.

Dave also proposed that we have VIP night at the pool for Village employees and board members and their families on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Lifeguard swim attire was discussed and decided that females could wear 2 piece swim suits. Nicole Jasper will help Charlie Bair with what is appropriate.

There will be "Free Family Nights" every Tuesday from 7p.m.-9p.m. with the starting date of June 5<sup>th</sup>. Dave Brandmeyer will work on getting volunteers to work the concession stand.

Teen Night will be held every other Friday, Dave will be looking for volunteers for this as well.

The entrance to the pool will change this year. Guests will enter by the concession stand.

### Civic Center

It was brought up that we need to be consistent with all long-term renters of the Civic Center. They should all be charged the same fee. \$25 per month or \$250 per year. Dave will talk to the seniors and the Lion's Club who use the civic center.

The Legion will be informed that they are to pay the rate of \$50 for 2 hours for their practices.
