General Trash Guidelines

- By law, only non-hazardous household solid wastes can be collected. Liquid waste products **cannot** be collected in a liquid state.
- Non-hazardous liquids can be mixed with an absorbent such as Kitty Litter, but **MUST** be completely dry & with the lid off the container to show the driver that it is dried out.
- All services are “curbside” which is placed within four feet (4’) of the traveled portion of the adjoining roadway.
- Trash with yard waste mixed in **cannot** be collected.
- Items over four feet (4’) high or long must be broken down or cut to four feet (4’) or less.
- Loose materials must be containerized or bundled.
- Trash is limited to the 95-gallon trash cart provided by Republic Services. All trash must be contained inside cart. Additional carts can be ordered by contacting New Baden Village Hall.
- Rubbish (waste that rots and stinks) should be bagged **AND** the bag(s) should be placed in trash carts. Republic Services will **NOT** be responsible for any rubbish spread about when animals or birds rip any such bag(s) open.
- Trash and recycle carts should be placed at least 5 (five) feet apart and away from any objects such as cars, mailboxes, or other trash receptacles. This is an automated system and the equipment requires room to maneuver and to prevent damages.
- Trash **cannot** be collected in cardboard boxes. Boxes must be broken down and placed inside 95-gallon recycle cart provided.
- **Bulky Trash** includes solid waste that cannot be placed into the 95-gallon trash cart. Bulky trash pick-ups are available with 2-item limit and at no charge. Bulky items must be prescheduled prior to pick up by calling Republic Services customer service. Bulky trash **DOES NOT** include major appliances, automobile parts or components, or any other such items.
- White Goods are to be scheduled for collection through Republic Services Customer Service. Cost per appliance pickup is \$20 and it must be prepaid and scheduled through Republic Services Customer Service at 618-656-6883.
- **Tires and Car Batteries** will not be collected.
- Medically necessary needles (**sharps**), such as diabetic syringes will only be collected when in **approved** sharps containers which are available from your syringe supplier or you may use a puncture proof container with a tightly closed lid.
- **Construction material** or the materials that result from home remodeling projects will not be picked up as part of normal trash or as bulk trash. Some examples of the materials we are unable to pick up: cabinets, drywall or sheetrock, wood (e.g., 2x4’s, plywood, paneling, peg board), bathroom fixtures (toilets, tubs, commodes), kitchen fixtures (cabinets, islands, etc.), plumbing (pipes, sinks), large light fixtures (if the fixture does not fit in a 32-gallon can with the lid secured normally, we are unable to pick up), roofing material (e.g., shingles, ceramic roof tiles, tar paper, gutters, fascia boards), siding, etc. This construction material list is not all-inclusive. Please

contact Republic Services Customer Service to inquire about having construction items picked up for an additional charge.

SENIOR RATES

Discount rate offered to residents aged 62 and older. Contact Village Hall at 618-588-3813 for more info. Republic Services will provide a 65-gallon garbage and/or recycle cart to those residents who receive the Senior Discount Rate upon request.

YARD WASTE GUIDELINES

- Yard waste is collected on Friday.
- Yard waste is a 3-month minimum commitment and is an additional charge to the customer.
- Yard waste is limited to eight (8) items.
- Yard waste with trash mixed in **cannot** be collected.
- Loose yard waste must be contained. Acceptable yard waste containers are 36-gallon containers marked with a red “X”, 2-ply Kraft paper bags or bundles of no more than 4’ in length and 3” in diameter and tied with string/twine. Containers cannot exceed 50lbs each.
- **YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS OR BOXES WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**
- Any limbs set out for pick up in cans should not exceed three inches (3”) over the top of the can.
- Tree limbs and branches less than four inches (4”) in diameter must be tied (with **TWINE – NO WIRE**) in bundles no bigger than four feet (4’) long by twenty-four inches (24”) in diameter; however, no bundle is to weigh more than 50 pounds. Limbs and branches four inches (4”) or more in diameter are considered Bulky Trash.
- Christmas trees will be collected at no additional charge the first 2 weeks in January. The tree must be free of all decorations including tinsel, garland, ornaments and lights. The tree must also be cut shorter than four feet (4’) in length.

RECYCLE GUIDELINES

Every other Week Service: Republic Services will provide a 95-gallon recycle cart. Recycle will be picked up every other Tuesday. Contact Village Hall for recycling schedule.

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

FREE Electronics Recycling on the 1st Saturday of each month at the New Baden Civic Center from 9-11am. Sponsored by the Citizens for a Better Tomorrow (a local not-for-profit). Any item that has a power cord is accepted. TVs and monitors are not accepted. For more information, call 618-588-4474.

COLLECTION SCHEDULES

Your Customer Service center will advise you of your current collection schedules. In order to insure collection of your trash, yard waste, and recycling, please put them out for collection at the curbside **BY 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.**

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be no collections on New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. The change in service days will be for that day on which the holiday falls. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, no change in weekly trash pickup will occur. When the holiday falls on a weekday, **ALL** days following a holiday **ROLL**.

For Example:

If the holiday is on a Monday:
Monday goes on Tuesday
Tuesday goes on Wednesday
Wednesday goes on Thursday
Thursday goes on Friday
Friday goes on Saturday
